**General Rules and Regulations**

1. Management, the Committee, and/or Three Runs Plantation will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any exhibitor, owner, attendant, horse or equipment at the show.
2. Management reserves the right to cancel any class if the required entries have not been received, and to combine any division if necessary, to change an obstacle or alter any course.
3. Proper attire is not mandatory except for headgear according to USEF Equestrian Federation rules.
4. NO person will be allowed in the ring at any time unless invited in by the management.
5. A fee of \$50.00 will be charged for all returned checks.
6. Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons will be awarded in all divisions.
7. Six Ribbons will be awarded in all classes.
8. Entry fee will be \$15.00 per class day of entry. Pre-entries are \$10.00 per class; \$25.00 for a pre-entered division. All pre-entries should be sent to: milkmoney4foals@aol.com
9. Entry fee for the Hunter Pace is \$35.00 day of and \$25.00 pre-entry. All pre-entries for the Hunter Pace should be sent to: islandcreations@att.net

12. Day of entry cut off times for schooling show will be 8 am in secretary's office located in the clubhouse. Day of entry cut off time for the hunter pace will be at 10:30am in the secretary's office inside the clubhouse.
13. All Dogs must be on a leash when on the property. This will be enforced and if you are in violation after being asked the first time you will be requested to leave the premises.
14. **CURRENT COGGINS REQUIRED.** A copy of current coggins must be submitted at the time of entries. No numbers will be given out without a current negative coggins report copy.
15. Breakfast and Lunch will be offered in the clubhouse.
16. The show committee reserves the right to change any class order or ring location in order to enhance the efficiency of the day.
17. Please use designated parking areas. You will be asked to move your vehicle if it is parked in the No Parking areas. There is no driving on the show grounds.
18. This is our first endeavor in combining so many disciplines in one day. As we will attempt complete flexibility to accommodate each rider in every way, we ask for patience and assistance where it may seem we need it. The day is about benefiting the orphan nurse mare foals and we ask that every competitor keep this in mind throughout the day. We want to learn from the days experience to improve next year's show. We thank you for your support, understanding and full co-operation.
